Citizens' Oversight Committee (COC) of the Cajon Valley Union School District

Minutes Unadopted

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the Citizens' Oversight Committee was called to order by Sharon Dobbins on October 4, 2023 at 3:33 p.m. via Zoom.

Members Present: Kevin Borum, Steve Devan, Susan Holtz, and Lori Trim. Apologies: Violetta Lombera

District Staff: Chris Ayers, Scott Buxbaum, Sharon Clay, Sharon Dobbins, Miranda Durning, Vickie Hayman, and Lisa Krueger.

WELCOME, ROLL CALL

Sharon called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone, thanking them for their attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes from the April 19, 2023 meeting were approved on a motion made by Steve, seconded by Susan and carried 4-0.

NEW MEMBERS AND CURRENT VACANCIES

New COC member, Kevin Borum was introduced. Kevin shared that he is the parent of students at Fuerte Elementary and Hillsdale Middle School. Sharon notified the Committee that Sheri Runyan has resigned from the COC because she has moved out of the District. There are currently two COC vacancies: one must be filled by a taxpayer representative, and the other by a member of the community-at-large.

BUDGET & PROJECT UPDATES

Prop C Bond Fund:

Sharon provided and reviewed the final Bond Program Budget Report ending June 30, 2023, discussing the identified budget adjustments:

- Interest earned of \$60,625 was added at the close of the fiscal year.
- Naranca Elementary School: A refund of \$11,620 was received from Helix Water District and recorded as revenue (rather than a negative expenditure), per state accounting requirements.
- Program Management: Contingency funds of \$75,000 were moved to the Program Management budget to be allocated toward the Facilities Master Plan update.

Scott discussed the Crest Erosion Control project, sharing that this is a much bigger project than originally anticipated. The District is reaching out to the County for support and assistance, as the flow of the water is coming from the county roadways. An architectural/engineering firm has been hired to design a new drainage system. Once the plans and specifications are complete, the project will go out for bid.

The District may soon receive state modernization funding of approximately \$2 million. These funds would reimburse a portion of the new classroom building at Johnson Elementary School and would increase the overall program contingency allowing for funding to add classrooms to accommodate expanded transitional kindergarten, as well as student support spaces. More information regarding this funding will be available soon.

The updated Facilities Master Plan will include an assessment of the District's facility needs and cost estimates. Needs will be prioritized, and funding options will be considered by the Governing Board. Most of the District's schools are currently eligible, or will soon become eligible for state modernization funds, but a local District match is required to access the funds.

Prop EE Bond Fund:

Sharon reviewed the technology bond fund expense reports dated June 30, 2023 and September 28, 2023, pointing out that these bonds are intended for classroom technology, and therefore, they are structured to be repaid over a shorter term than the construction bonds. They are typically repaid within approximately three years.

Shortly after the last technology bond issuance, Federal stimulus funds were received and used for student technology devices, allowing the bond funds to last longer, leaving an uncommitted technology bond fund balance as of September 28, 2023 of \$6,057,617.06 million. A portion of the interest earned (arbitrage) must be refunded to the IRS, since the District is limited in the amount of interest it can earn on bond funds. Arbitrage calculations are completed by the District's financial advisor, and excess interest earnings are refunded to the IRS, as required, within five years of each bond issuance.

MEETING / CALENDAR

Sharon shared that the member list and meeting calendar have been updated. Please refer to the website or let Sharon know if anyone knows someone that may be interested in serving on the COC.

Sharon noted that the draft Annual Report will be sent to the committee for review prior to the April meeting.

The next meeting on April 3, 2024, will be in person. Further information will be sent via email closer to the meeting date.

DISCUSSION / OTHER

Steve inquired about the possibility of visiting Crest to see the impact of the drainage issues in person. Scott offered to meet with Steve and Johnny to review the information and drive to Crest if desired.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:15 p.m.

To: The Board of Trustees and the Citizens' of the Cajon Valley Union School District

The Citizens' Oversight Committee (COC) is pleased to present its 15th Annual Report to the Community. The COC is an independent committee appointed to inform the public concerning the Cajon Valley Union School District's bond programs. This report provides an overview of the current bond programs, project status information, and audit summary.

The District has used its school construction bond funding to build and renovate school facilities, which improves learning environments for students and decreases ongoing maintenance and energy costs for taxpayers.

Short-term (3-year) technology bonds have been used to increase student access to computers and to maintain and upgrade educational technology to prepare Cajon Valley students for successful futures.

<u>The annual financial and performance audit</u> was completed by the independent Certified Public Accounting firm of Christy White Inc. As in all past years, the audit results were favorable with no instances of non-compliance.

2023 PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- Facilities Master Plan: The District completed a facility needs assessment, gathered input from stakeholders and began drafting its updated Facilities Master Plan.
- Hillsdale MS Multi-purpose Building Upgrades: Design of the Hillsdale Middle School's Multi-purpose Building Upgrade project was completed. This project will go out to bid in early 2024..
- Sevick School Renovation Planning: Design of the Sevick Special Education Preschool Renovation project was completed using contingency funds.



SEVICK RENOVATON PLANNING

• Classroom Technology (Prop EE short-term technology bonds): A majority of the classroom technology devices, which were originally planned to be purchased from Prop EE funds were able to be purchased using federal stimulus funds. Current Prop EE funding is being set aside for future replacements.

PLANNED FOR 2024

- ⇒ **Facilities Master Plan:** The District's Facilities Master Plan will be completed in early 2024.
- ⇒ **Hillsdale MS Multi-purpose Building Upgrades:** Hillsdale Middle School's Multi-purpose Building upgrades will be completed in 2024.
- ⇒ **New Classrooms for Expanded TK and Support Services:** As the bond program comes to a close, remaining contingency funds will be used to add portable classroom buildings to accommodate expanded transitional kindergarten and student support services.
- Classroom Technology (Prop EE short-term technology bonds): Student computers will
 continue to be purchased using available federal stimulus funds. Prop EE funds will be used for
 other classroom technology device replacements such as projectors and document cameras.

COMPLETED PROJECTS

Anza Elementary School — New Classroom Buildings: Six old portable classrooms were replaced with



new, permanent classroom buildings, which include restrooms, and learning support spaces. A new playground was also added. The new buildings were

occupied in August 2019.



Cajon Valley Middle
School Rebuilding
Project: Construction
of the final new building
was completed in
August 2011. This

project, which completes the rebuilding of the entire school campus, consists of 20 classrooms, a library, and serving kitchen.

Clock Systems: New Clock Systems were installed at Anza, Chase, Fuerte, Hall, Johnson, Madison, Magnolia, Meridian, and Naranca Elementary Schools, as well as, Emerald and Greenfield Middle Schools, and EJE Charter Academy.

Electrical Upgrades: Electrical upgrade projects were completed over the Summer 2010 at Chase Elementary, Madison Elementary and Emerald Middle School.

Fencing Projects: Fencing enhancements were completed at all schools to improve security.

Heating Ventilation & Air Conditioning Replacements: The HVAC replacements were completed each summer at the following sites: Anza, Chase, Crest, Madison, Meridian and Naranca in 2010; Emerald, Flying Hills, Fuerte, Johnson, Magnolia, and Rancho San Diego in 2011; EJE/Cuyamaca in 2012; Vista Grande in 2013; Bostonia and Montgomery in 2016.

Johnson Elementary School - New Classroom

Buildings: Nine old portable classrooms were replaced with a new, permanent 2-story classroom building, which include restrooms, and



learning support spaces. The new building was occupied in September 2020.

Lexington Elementary School — Rebuilding: This



new school was constructed adjacent to the original (60-year old) school on the existing 9 acre campus. The

original school buildings served as interim housing during construction, and were demolished when the new facility was completed in summer 2015.

Lighting Retrofits: Energy efficient lighting was installed at all sites.

Locker Room Upgrades/Egress: Upgrades were made to middle school locker rooms for safe egress and compliance with current code requirements.

Magnolia Elementary School — New Classroom Building and Renovations: Old portable classroom buildings were removed and replaced with a new building, including 8 classrooms; 2 staff restrooms; and 2 office/small group instruction spaces. The renovations include: multipurpose building remodeling; kitchen expansion;

creation of additional small group instruction spaces and a library/maker space; as well as, classroom and playground renovations.



COMPLETED PROJECTS (continued)

Minor Renovations: Minor Renovations were completed at Bostonia, Chase, Flying Hills, Fuerte, Hall, Johnson, Madison, Magnolia, Naranca, and Rios Elementary Schools, as well as Hillsdale Middle School and Sevick Preschool. The renovations were primarily remodeling/reconfigurations to increase security.

Modernization — Rancho San Diego: The Rancho San Diego Modernization project was completed in September 2012. This project included renovation of the existing campus, as well as replacement of three portable classroom buildings with new steel/wood-framed modular classrooms, including restrooms. Additional remodeling to move the office to the front of the campus, for improved security, was completed in the summer of 2017.



Modernization – Vista Grande: The Vista Grande modernization project, which included renovation of the existing campus, as well as replacement of four portable classroom buildings with new steel/wood-framed modular classrooms, was substantially completed over the summer of 2012. New porticos and accessible parking improvements were completed over winter break of 2012/2013. Additional remodeling to move the office to the front of the campus, for improved security, was completed in the summer of 2017.

Multipurpose Building Expansion — Flying Hills Elementary School: 1162 sq. ft. was added to the multipurpose building, as well as, a 1162 sq. ft. basement below for storage of props and costumes. Construction began in October 2009 and was completed in April 2010.

Naranca Elementary School — New Classroom Buildings: Seven old portable classrooms were replaced with new, permanent classroom buildings, which include restrooms, and learning support spaces. The new buildings were occupied in August 2021.



New Gymnasium/ Multipurpose Building/ Administration & Kitchen Buildings (Emerald Middle School) This project, which includes a new

indoor gymnasium/ multipurpose building, locker rooms, kitchen, lunch shelter, and school office was constructed using the d e s i g n - b u i l d



procurement method. The new buildings were occupied in August 2016.

New Gymnasium / Multipurpose Building (Greenfield Middle School): This project, which



includes: a gymnasium; locker rooms; theater; music/band room; serving kitchen;

COMPLETED PROJECTS (continued)

New Gymnasium & Renovation (Montgomery Middle School): The Montgomery Middle School project includes: a new gymnasium/multipurpose building; swimming pool, tennis court, and locker room renovations; painting; reroofing; new classroom skylights; and landscape/



hardscape improvements. The project was completed in summer/fall 2015.

Parking Lot Upgrades: Parking lot upgrades were completed at Avocado and WD Hall Elementary Schools in 2013.

Playground Upgrades: New playground equipment was



installed at Anza, Meridian, Naranca, and W.D. Hall Elementary Schools in summer 2009. Blossom Valley Elementary School playground upgrades were completed in summer 2010.

Additionally, new playground equipment was installed at Lexington and Magnolia elementary schools as part of the new construction projects at those sites.

Security Cameras: Security cameras were installed at Anza, Avocado, Bostonia, Flying Hills, Hall, Johnson, Madison, and Naranca Elementary Schools and Cajon Valley, Emerald, Greenfield, Hillsdale, and Montgomery Middle Schools from 2009 through 2017.

Security Lighting: Exterior, LED motion-controlled lighting was installed at all campuses.

Sevick Renovation Planning: Schematic design was completed for future renovations at Sevick School.

Sidewalk/Walkway Replacements: Old, cracked walkways were replaced with new concrete walkways at Greenfield Middle School.

Technology (Infrastructure): Technology



infrastructure upgrades were completed at all schools. The upgrades include: cabling; data storage and management system; IDF (Intermediate Distribution Frame) and MDF (Main Distribution Frame) e q u i p m e n t r o o m modifications; campus-wide

wireless access; infrastructure for Internet-accessible projectors; and Voice Over Internet Protocol (VoIP) phone systems.

Technology (Educational Technology): Short-term bonds were used to fund a portion of the cost for educational technology devices for the District-wide I:I initiative.

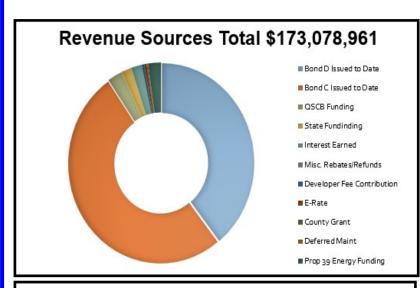


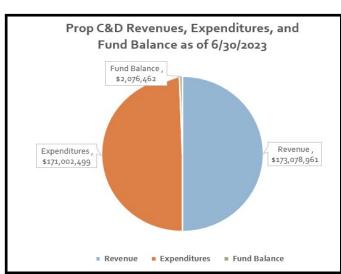
Waterline Project: A new waterline was installed at Meridian Elementary in Spring 2008.

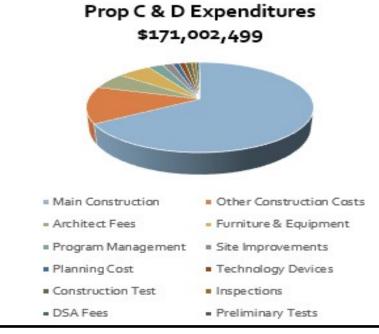
Window Replacements: Windows were replaced at Blossom Valley Elementary, Jamacha Elementary and Hillsdale Middle School from 2016 to 2018.

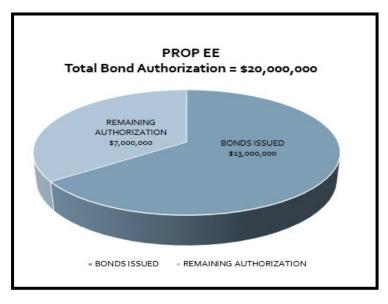

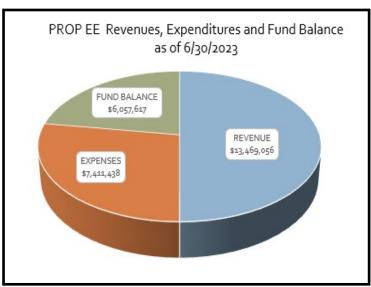

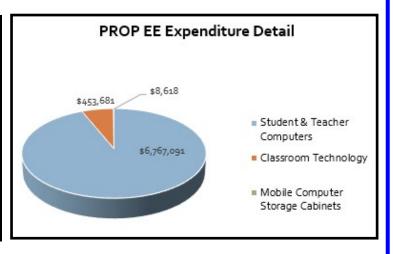
