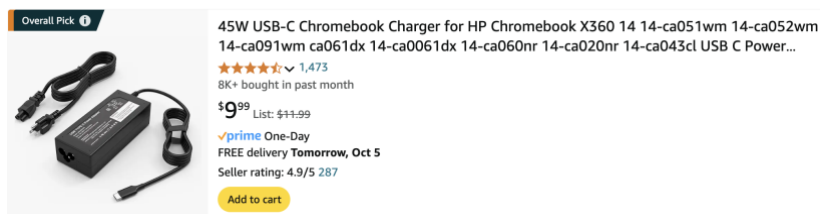
**TRIMESTER 1 GRADES CLOSE:** Trimester 1 Ends on October 29<sup>th</sup>!!! This will be the last day for students to make up and turn in missing assignments. Please make sure your student completes all assignments **in their entirety**, so credit is issued, and the assignment title, student's full name and class period are clearly written at the top. **PLEASE REMEMBER, THE TRIMESTER 1 REPORT CARDS ARE REFLECTED ON YOUR STUDENT'S PERMANENT SCHOOL RECORDS.**

**TRIMESTER 2 BEGINS NOVEMBER 4<sup>TH</sup>:** Trimester 2 begins on Monday, November 4<sup>th</sup>. This means that all students have a fresh start on their academic, citizenship, and effort grades. It is the student's responsibility to keep up with daily assignments, whether at school or absent. **Please remember, zeros are very detrimental to overall grades and academic success.**

### **DOES YOUR STUDENT STILL HAVE HIS/HER CHROMEBOOK CHARGER???**

It is required for every student to bring their charged chromebook and a charger to school every day. If your student needs to use their chromebook in every class throughout the school day, it has no to little charge by 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> period and your student is not able to complete the class requirements for that day and may fall behind. Please help your student and us teachers by making sure your student charges his/her chromebook every night as well as bring their charger to school.

**Week #10 = 10 I-Ready Assignments Completed and Passed by yesterday at 8:59 pm!**

**I-READY:** I-Ready is a district-purchased an online program for mathematics that will help personalize your student's learning and monitor progress throughout the school year. I-Ready consists of two parts: Diagnostic and Personalized Instruction that provides data to increase your student's learning gains.

This year, your student is required to take 3 diagnostic assessments and complete 1 math lesson per week. Every four weeks the I-Ready will be graded and students will earn a score reflective of the number of lessons they have completed to date. **Students who have completed 4/4 by week 4, 8/8 by week 8, 12/12 by week 12, and so on, will be able to participate in P.A.T. (Preferred Activity Time).** Students who have not completed the required lessons will work on I-Ready during that time.

**I-READY LESSONS ARE DUE ON THE DAY BEFORE P.A.T. BY 8:59 PM. ANYTHING SUBMITTED AFTER 8:59 PM WILL NOT COUNT FOR THAT PARTICULAR WEEK.**

#### **FREE ONLINE TUTORING:**

**INFRACTIONS:** An Infraction Log is kept daily for violations of basic school and classroom rules, which include but are not limited to the following: Gum, Tardy, Cell Phone ON, Inappropriate Use of Technology, Disruption, Not bringing necessary school supplies (charged chromebook and charger), Profanity, Dress Code, etc. **EVERY 3 INFRACTIONS RESULT IN ONE LOWERED CITIZENSHIP GRADE.**

**TIMES TESTS:** Every four weeks, all students will be taking a multiplication facts quiz (100 facts, 0's through 12's in 6 minutes). We have been working on this periodically in class, however you could also help your student at home to prepare for this quiz.

- 1) Make multiplication flash cards and quiz your student.
- 2) Print each of the four different Times Test forms from my [website](#) and practice, practice, practice!
- 3) Log onto Hoodamath.com and have your student practice the multiplication timed test online.
- 4) Play Multiplication War with a deck of cards (remove the Kings, Queens = 12, Jacks = 11, and Aces = 1).

**GRADES:** I update grades every FRIDAY and post them in my gradebook program iGrade Plus to be emailed to you on Fridays. If you and your student check his/her math grade before Friday, there may be blank entries. This means I have yet to enter the grades for that assignment, so please check back on Friday. Assignments turned in on Friday will NOT be reflected on the emailed report until the following week.

**If you do not receive an emailed grade report today, please email me a working email for you so I can update my records. Be sure to include your student's first and last name in the subject line of your email.**
