Welcome back to school! I hope you enjoyed your summer with your child(ren) and are ready for a very busy and productive 2024-2025 school year. I am very pleased to inform you that I am your student's math teacher this year. I will be sending weekly emails informing you of the "goings on" in class with assignment information, upcoming events/dates, as well as linking my lesson plans for the following week.

PARENT LETTER: Thank you for taking the time to read my Parent Letter, which was sent home with your student on the first day of school. The second sheet was completed and returned by most students; However, I am still missing a few. I have also attached a copy of my parent letter to this email in case you need to reference it throughout the school year.

TIMES TESTS: In two weeks, on September 6^{th} , and every four weeks after, all students will be taking a multiplication facts quiz (100 facts, 0's through 12's in 6 minutes). We have been working on this periodically in class, however you could also help your student at home to prepare for this quiz.

- 1) Make multiplication flash cards and guiz your student.
- 2) Print each of the four different Times Test forms from my website and practice, practice, practice!
- 3) Log onto Hoodamath.com and have your student practice the multiplication timed test online.
- 4) Play Multiplication War with a deck of cards (remove the Kings, Queens = 12, Jacks = 11, and Aces = 1).

GRADES: It is important for you to know I will be using iGrade Plus instead of the district program, Q-Zangle because it allows me to email weekly progress reports directly to parents. I will only update grades in Q-Zangle at the end of each 6-week grading period. Please do not check your student's weekly grade in Q-Zangle.

I update grades every FRIDAY and post them in my gradebook program iGrade Plus to be emailed to you on Fridays. If you and your student check his/her math grade before Friday, there may be blank entries.

This means I have yet to enter the grades for that assignment, so please check back on Friday.

Assignments turned in on Friday will NOT be reflected on the emailed report until the following week.

THE FIRST GRADE REPORT WILL BE EMAILED OUT TODAY. If you do not receive an emailed grade report today, please email me a working email for you so I can update my records. Be sure to include your student's first and last name in the subject line of your email.

You and your student will also be receiving an invitation to gain access to the iGrade Plus online grade program, so you are able to check your student's math grade at any time. Be on the lookout for an email TODAY with instructions on how to set up your iGrade Plus parent portal account.
