PRIMARY FUNCTION

- Support District School Nurses and Health Care Specialists to organize, implement and evaluate the health service programs
- Support the development and implementation of District wide Health Services guidelines
- Design professional learning

AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY

- Serves as a primary resource for health issues within the District.
- Develops and makes recommendations regarding policies and procedures in health-related areas, and interprets these policies and procedures for staff and the community partners.
- Work collaboratively and/or independently to plan, design, and facilitate professional learning, which include integrating technology and other support materials.
- Coordinates and ensures compliance with all state mandated health screenings and immunization requirements.
- Develops and provides training in specialized health care procedures.
- Designs, provides, and participates in in-service training to staff regarding health services and health education.
- Represents the District with the County Health Department and other community agencies.
- Support district professional learning.
- Other essential job-related work as assigned.
- Work hours are consistent with normal District office hours up to an eight-hour day.

JOB REQUIREMENTS

- School Nurse Services Credential.
- Strong interpersonal skills and ability to work collaboratively with administrators as well as certificated and classified staff.
- Knowledge of state-adopted standards and current evidence-based nursing practice.
- Experience in analyzing student data and work to determine appropriate interventions, supports, and extensions.
- Minimum of three years successful school nursing experience.
- Personal transportation, verification of insurance coverage.



EDUCATION

A Bachelor's Degree in Nursing or an area of specialization related to health and nursing services required.

LICENSES

- School Nurse Services Credential issued by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
- State of California Registered Nurse license in good standing.
- State of California driver's license.
- CPR/AED Certificate.
- Audiometry Certificate.

- Indoor/office setting.
- Driving a vehicle to conduct work.
- Subject to attending evening meetings.

PHYSICAL ABILITIES

- Dexterity of hands and fingers to operate a computer keyboard.
- Sitting or standing for extended periods of time.
- Hearing and speaking to exchange information and make presentations.
