

Guidelines for Parents with Ill Students

Cajon Valley Union School Districts' endeavor is to prevent the spread of disease among students. For the protection of your own child, as well as classmates, students with **ANY** of the symptoms listed below **MUST** stay home.

- Fever $\geq 100^{\circ}$ F
- Persistent cough
- Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing
- New or undiagnosed rash
- New loss of taste or smell*
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Swollen glands or stiff neck
- Inflamed, draining eye

Your Child May Return to School When

Fever	New or undiagnosed rash	Inflamed, draining eye	Vomiting/ Diarrhea	Positive for COVID-19	All other listed symptoms above
Your child is fever free (without taking fever reducing medication) for at least 24 hours before returning to school.	Your child's rash must be covered if still visible, able to participate in daily activities, and/or criteria for sending home is resolved.	Your child has taken prescribed medication for at least 24 hours, is able to participate in daily activities, and/or criteria for sending home is resolved.	No vomiting or diarrhea without taking medication for at least 24 hours before returning to school.	According to current CVUSD COVID-19 Procedures. Contact the school office for a return date.	Once symptoms have improved and your child is able to participate in daily activities. *Refer to COVID-19 guidance for new loss of taste or smell.

Chronic Health Conditions

Students who have symptoms associated with COVID-19 but are due to a known chronic health condition must provide the following in order to attend school (CH-97). Once the CH-97 is confirmed by the assigned District Nurse, the student may return to school.

- A signed note from a licensed MD/DO/NP/PA (who manages their condition)
- The note must confirm the chronic diagnosis (e.g. cite labs, date diagnoses)
- Explain how symptoms are unrelated to COVID-19
- Include provider's contact information **AND**
- Be accompanied by signed consent for school to interact with MD/DO/NP/PA

If your child is sick, please ensure you notify the school of your child's absence. Thank you for your understanding and support as we strive to provide a safe and healthy educational environment.
